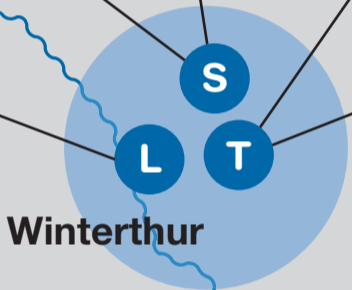

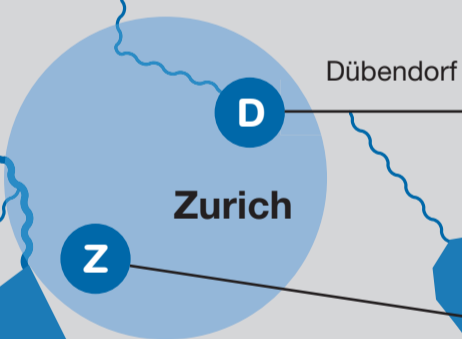

## Resources and services

### Resources

At the ZHAW University Library, you have access to more than 140,000 media items. Besides [monographs](#), printed [periodicals](#) and other types of media, you have full-text access to several thousand [e-books](#) and over 9,000 [e-journals](#). The [Electronic Journals Library \(EZB\)](#) is quick and reliable in finding your desired title. Please also ask our staff members – they'll be glad to help you!

### Specialised databases

On campus, you have access, free of charge, to over 100 bibliographic and full-text databases, thanks to an online licence.

### Interlibrary loans/Obtaining documents

The ZHAW University Library is part of NEBIS, the network of Swiss libraries. The NEBIS catalogue contains over 4 million titles, the «Informationsverbund Deutschschweiz» (IDS) over 13 million titles and the Karlsruhe Virtual Catalogue (KVK) over 500 million titles. You can order most of these titles through an interlibrary loan and pick them up at your own library. Should you be unable to find a certain document, please ask us and we will be glad to help you obtain any available documents.

### Search support and promotion of information literacy

The Internet, databases and a multitude of catalogues and new information mediums have greatly diversified the search for material. Search engines and meta-catalogues give access to a large amount of information. It is not always clear who the author is, where the information is coming from and how it can be verified. We advise you on the use of available resources and on how to obtain media and information. We also offer our professional assistance to help you:

- find your way around the ZHAW University Library
- obtain information about collection and the services
- use our resources efficiently through effective searches in the NEBIS and IDS network catalogues, databases and other sources of information.

In addition, we run special training modules, in cooperation with the Schools, to promote information literacy.

## Using the library and borrowing books

All the items in our collection are freely accessible and can be borrowed, with the exception of non-circulating materials.

Every loan transaction must be recorded. For this purpose, a user card is required, which you will receive, free of charge, at the library after online registration.

If you already have a user card for IDS or NEBIS or a ZHAW CampusCard, then you just have to register as a user.
