

#### **Demographic & epidemiologic changes in Germany**


Birth rate minus 50 % since 1964

## "Doing things differently"

Increase collaboration in traditionals tasks, due to increasing complexity



"Doing different things"

Carry out new tasks previously performed by doctors

#### There are legal uncertainties in task sharing and responsibilities

Task sharing / reallocation must be in accordance with

- 1. complexity of task
- 2. professional qualification of all parties involved

Qualification is vital to legally enable healthcare professionals to perform complex tasks



#### Physician Assistants in Germany – reasoning


- demographic & epidemiologic changes in Germany
- shortage of Healthcare Professionals
- silo mentality
- need to do things differently & need to do different things
- legal uncertainties
- task sharing & delegation requires (academic) qualification due to increasing complexity
- majority of physicians in Germany (and Europe) now agree more with task sharing / reallocation




- Decision of the 117th German Medical Assembly 2014 to set up a working group "academically educated Health Professions" of the BÄK and KBV to develop of a concept for a nationwide professional "Physician Assistant (PA)"
- German Medical Assembly continues to vote in 2015 and 2016 for a nationally regulated occupational profile Physician Assistant (PA)
- The 120th German Medical Assembly 2017 publishes the guideline "Physician Assistant – a new profession in German healthcare"

#### **Number of PA-students:**

2015 = 225 (published 2016)

Academic Year 2019/20 approximately 1.000 students (own data)

#### **Number of PA-graduates:**

179 - 300 (published 2017 & 2018)

1.000 Graduates in 2019 (own data & DGPA)






## Are you satisfied working as PA?

## Summary

- Increase of students in the PA programs
- Substantial increase of the number of universities with PA programs
- Increase of Physician Assistants in medical care
- Majority of graduates is working in hospitals
- General framework for PA Bachelor programs is determined

## The PA profession is now established in Germany

- named to be one of the top jobs 2019

## Outlook

- Expert group developed curriculum especially for PA in outpatient care - will be implemented and published shortly
- First Masters program for PA will start in 2020
- Implementing standards for tests and examinations (European Certificate)
- Expansion of clinical training sites
- Optimizing the political and legal framework
- Enhancing collaboration with international partners
