Description	In this course Swiss and international students in health professions and social work meet and learn together and from each other. The focus of the week (Monday-Friday) is to discuss and address issues related to interprofessional collaboration in health and social care. Lecturers and students will present the organization of the health and social system in their own country. Study visits at the interface of the Swiss health and social care system will provide us with an insight into interprofessional approaches and challenges in practice.
Learning Goals	<p>By the end of the course students</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> describe the organization of the social and health care system in their country and make themselves understood with students of other health and social profession from other countries. discuss similarities and differences of the presented social and health care systems using a systematic approach. distinguish different types of interprofessional collaboration within selected social and health care institutions. reflect the interprofessional cooperation in their own professional work field.
