

Mobility grants for EU¹ and UK students studying in Switzerland

Switzerland has developed a solution Swiss European Mobility Programme (SEMP) to fund incoming students from partner institutions. This solution will be in place as long as Switzerland has not re-gained full participation in the Erasmus+ program.

The regulations are very similar to the ones of Erasmus+:

Obligatory documents	<p><u>Before you go</u>: Grant agreement incl. bank details, Learning/Training Agreement, Insurance Declaration (student mobility for studies)</p> <p><u>After your stay</u>: Certificate of attendance, Final report, Narrative article</p>

What do I have to do to get a mobility grant for Switzerland?

Step 1: Apply at your university for admission to study or to a placement at ZHAW School of Health Sciences

→ Contact person: international coordinator at your university

Step 2: Registration at ZHAW and application for a mobility grant

→ Contact the International Office (international.gesundheit@zhaw.ch)

→ You will have to register in our online system "Mobility Online"

→ Deadlines: autumn semester – July, spring semester – December

Step 3: Payment of the grant

→ Payment will be made to a Swiss or international account in Swiss Francs.

→ First payment: 60% of total amount during the first month of your stay

→ Final payment: after you have handed in all documents (see Step 4)

Step 4: After your stay at ZHAW you have to hand in at ZHAW

→ Final report

→ Narrative article/blog 1-2 pages incl. pictures describing your experience in Switzerland to be published on our Webpage

→ Your Transcript of Records (TOR) will be issued as soon as we have received these documents from you
